Follow Up Actions to resident concerns on December 05, 2022

During the citizen comment portion of the December 5th, 2022 legislative session staff was asked to investigate and report back on the following inquiries:

1. Quality of drinking water;
2. Town's inoperable vehicle tow policy; and
3. Installation of the traffic signal at Rt. 13 and UMES Blvd.

Water Quality:

- Staff attended the December 8th Sanitary District meeting and requested their attendance at the January 3rd Legislative session.
- The Board members agreed to have representatives present to answer questions, give contact information and provide updates.

Inoperable vehicle tow policy:

- Staff reviewed all open and closed inoperable vehicle cases.
- The review did not yield evidence that any vehicles were towed in less than ten days of notification.
- A policy change was implemented that requires a notice be left on the front door of the effected property in addition to the notice posted on the vehicle. Vehicles will only be towed if the owner has not responded or taken some action within 14 days of receiving notice.

Traffic signal at RT. 13 and UMES Blvd:

- The traffic signal has been planned and improved. The installation is stalled due to supply chain delays.
