**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-01**

A RESOLUTION OF THE PRESIDENT AND TOWN COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF PRINCESS ANNE, MARYLAND, TO ALLOCATE FUNDS FROM THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN TO RESPOND TO PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCIES AND TO MEET URGENT COMMUNITY NEEDS BECAUSE OF THE ECONOMIC IMPACT OF COVID 19.

WHEREAS, funds are available to the Town of Princess Anne under the American Rescue Plan, which can be allocated to meet the urgent needs of the community because of the negative economic impact of COVID 19; and

WHEREAS, the American Rescue Plan award funds are designed to respond to public health emergencies and meet urgent community needs; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Town of Princess Anne desire to provide economic support and relief for small businesses located and registered within the Town of Princess Anne; and

WHEREAS, the maximum benefit to a small business shall not exceed \$2,500 per business/applicant; and


WHEREAS, the maximum allocation for the small businesses shall not exceed \$125,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the President and Town Commissioners of Princess Anne, have determined that the community and citizens of the Town of Princess Anne would benefit from the American Rescue Plan award funds to provide economic support and relief to small businesses located and registered within the Town of Princess Anne, as follows:


1. Business/Applicant must employ ten (10) people or less;
2. Business/Applicant must be registered with the State of Maryland or Somerset County as a business in the corporate boundaries of the Town of Princess Anne prior to August 1, 2021;
3. Business/Applicant must be in good financial standing with the Town of Princess Anne, without any outstanding bills, taxes, or liens.
4. Business/Applicant must provide government issued photo identification.
5. Business/Applicant must provide a copy of the business license.
6. If an Applicant owns multiple Businesses, only one Business shall be eligible for a benefit.
7. Non-profit corporations and community organizations do not qualify for the benefit.
8. The benefit shall be \$2,500 per qualified Business.
9. To be eligible, the Business/Applicant must file an application by ~~March 1, 2022.~~






