RESOLUTION NO. 2022-07

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE ANNUAL BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF PRINCESS ANNE CONSISTING OF THE OPERATING AND CAPITAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2023, TO ACCEPT 2023 HIGHWAY SAFETY GRANTS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,991.16 FOR DUI, \$1,497.57 FOR OCCUPANT/DISTRACTED, \$1,497.57 FOR SPEED, AND \$2,995.14 FOR PED FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2023; AND TO ACCEPT A CRITICAL AREA GRANT 2023 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,000.00.

WHEREAS, the President and Commissioners of the Town of Princess Anne, Maryland, prepared a 2023 budget for the Town of Princess Anne Fiscal Year 2023; and desire to amend the 2023 Budget to include certain Highway Safety Grants and Critical Area Grant 2023; and




2023 Highway Safety Grants:

OCCUPANT/DISTRACTED -	\$1,497.57
SPEED -	\$1,497.57
PED -	\$2,995.14
CRITICAL AREA GRANT 2023:	\$2,000.00


