**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-09**

**A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDING FROM THE COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING SERVICES (COPS) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$125,000 AND REALLOCATE GRANT FUNDS TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE TOWN'S SHARE OF THE COST OF A NEW RECRUIT OVER THE FIRST THREE YEARS IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$64,362.99.**

WHEREAS, the President and Commissioners of the Town of Princess Anne, Maryland, desire to accept grant funding from the Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) in the amount of \$125,000 and allocate a portion of the grant funds from the General Fund for a new recruit in the Police Department over the first three years of employment in the total amount of \$64,362.99; and


