The Commissioners of the Town of Princess Anne announce the opening of the Town's "FAÇADE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM" funded by a grant from the State of Maryland's Department of Housing/Community Development's/DHCD Community Legacy Program. The total amount of grant funds available is \$75,000.

The Town of Princess Anne's "FAÇADE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM" will assist business owners AND residents with the cost of improving the facades of their buildings, thus encouraging private investment in properties. Additionally, it is the goal of the program to encourage positive development in the Town and beautify the neighborhood.

Eligible applicants must have properties located within the boundary of the Town's "Sustainable Community" which can be verified by contacting the Town Office's Department of Planning/Zoning.

Interested parties are requested to contact the Town Hall for an application which will include the necessary documents required for submission and program guidelines. Applications are required to be submitted by January 1, 2025 and review will commence upon receipt of submitted application. Grants will be awarded pursuant to program guidelines and on a "first come, first serve" basis. It is anticipated that all awards will be finalized by February 15, 2025.
